COURSE DETAILS

This exciting CASA qualification is relevant to the role of a Remote Pilot – Visual Line of Sight working in the Aviation Industry, below 400 feet above ground level, in day visual meteorological conditions (VMC).

Remote pilot duties include applying technical and non technical aviation skills and knowledge within RPAS (remotely piloted aircraft systems) operational environments, and meets a number of Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) Certification Requirements.

Whether you are a photographer wanting to explore the world of aerial photography, commercial or government operator or even about to purchase your first UAV, this qualification delivered by CASA Approved Training Organisation UAV Training Australia will prepare you for a range of career pathways along with CASA licensing outcomes as a next generation pilot.

PREREQUISITE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Operational flight crew are to satisfy General and Aviation English Language Proficiency (ELP). All new learners must complete the Aeronautical Radio Operators Certificate (AROC) (minimum age 17 years) General English Language Proficiency as directed by Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) and CASA approved Chief Instructor Mr Wayne Condon.

QUALIFICATION

Training will be delivered face to face where the student will attend classes with CASA qualified trainers and assessors, including practice and assessment of physical remote pilot skills using a hands on approach.

Instructor lead tutorials along with an on-line learning management system allows UAV candidates to study at their own pace and prepare them for the CASA on-line theory assessment which is conducted in-house by UAV Training Australia.

LEARNER COHORT

This CASA qualification is for candidates new to aviation and remote piloting, or learners who may have previous aviation qualifications such as recreational, private and/or commercial pilots license and wish to use their current skills to extend into a new branch of remote piloting aviation.

DURATION

The completion time-frame for the initial CASA Licensing qualification is 6 days full-time, with additional on-line CASA theory assessments required.

Candidates seeking the AROC will be required to undergo an additional 1 day CASA certified training program.

Durations may vary between new learners and those who have recognised previous aviation qualifications or UAV experience.
